Leaf and Brush Pick-up

Leaves will be picked up at the curb on **November 7, 14, and 21, 2019** leaves must be in brown paper leaf bags. Plastic bags will not be picked up. Brush will be picked up at the curb on **November 8, 15 and 22, 2019**; brush must be cut no longer than 4 feet and no wider than 3 inches in diame-

ter and must be bundled and tied so one man can handle the bundle. **Piles of brush NOT BUNDLED will not be picked up.** This is a brush pick-up only. Entire trees which have been removed will not be pick-up. Brush from lot clearing and firewood will not be picked up.

BE AWARE OF PHONE SCAMS



Please be aware of phone scams, most of which target the elderly, such as IRS calling and threatening to arrest you unless immediate payment is made. The IRS only communicates via letters that are mailed. There are also phone scams where the caller says that a loved one has been arrested such as a niece, nephew or grandchild and the caller demands payment to keep them out of jail. That call is a scam, especially if they ask you to wire money and send iTunes cards. Awareness of these scams

is the best prevention and if you aren't sure, call and ask the Police before doing anything further

Pet Owner Information

All dogs and cats residing in the Borough of Ogdensburg must be licensed yearly by January 31 and have a current rabies vaccination that does not expire prior to November 1st of that licensing year.

If you walk your dog please be prepared with plastic bags to clean up after your pet. Pet waste is not only a health hazard, containing coliform bacteria and other pollutants that can contaminate

our streams, lakes and rivers, but also a nuisance in our neighborhoods. **Reminder:** No person owning any animal shall permit such animal to run at large. Animals must be properly leashed on public land and roadways as per Borough Code Chapter 4-7.1. In accordance with Borough Code Chapter 4-7.2 no person owning or harboring any animal shall permit such animal to bark, howl or

cry continuously for more than one half hour at any given time.

Police Department Reminders “Snow Removal”

The Police Department would like to remind everyone to facilitate snow removal, no person shall park a vehicle on any street in the Borough when streets are snow covered and when the Borough is in the process of removing or cleaning the streets of snow. Borough Code Chapter 7 10.1.

Any unoccupied vehicle stopped or standing in violation of this section, shall be deemed a nuisance to the safe and proper regulation of traffic, and any Police Officer or member of the Borough of Public Works Department

may provide for the removal of such vehicle. The owner of such vehicle shall be responsible for the cost of removal and storage before regaining possession of the vehicle. Borough Code Chapter 7 10.2.

Please insure you lock your vehicle and residence doors; if you notice any suspicious or criminal activity, contact the Borough Police Department. Remember if your car has a push button start remember to remove your key fob from the car.

With school back in session for our children safety, obey all the speed limits and remember to lower your speed during inclement weather.

Garbage and Recycling Information

Every Wednesday—Household Garbage—limited to (2) 32 gallon containers. If you have additional trash and need to place more household garbage out for pickup, you will need to purchase a sticker at the Borough Hall at \$2.00 per sticker and place one sticker on each additional bag of garbage.

The first Wednesday of the month one bulky item is permitted to be

left at the curb. Bulky items include furniture, carpeting and mattresses. **THE FOLLOWING WILL NOT BE PICKED UP:** Refrigerators, clothes washers, dryers, ranges, dishwashers, water heaters, air conditioners, trash compactors, freezers, dehumidifiers and furnaces. Recyclables will be picked up every other Thursday, unlimited containers; please avoid plastic pages. Recyclables =

newspapers, magazines, cardboard, junk mail, office paper, wrapping paper, cardboard rolls, tissue, cereal and juice boxes, waxed cartons cans, bottle, jars, plastic toys, milk crates, laundry baskets, plastic buckets, flower pots, totes and broken plastic furniture.

Electronic waste will not be picked up, televisions, desktop or laptop computers, monitors etc.
