BOARD OF HEALTH MEETING**

October 5, 2016

THE OGDENSBURG BOARD OF HEALTH MEETING was called to order at 8:00pm.

STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE: The notice requirement of the Open Public Meeting Act, NJSA 10:4-6 have been satisfied with a schedule of all meetings together with the time, location and agenda of all the same being sent to the New Jersey Herald and posted on the bulletin board on January 6, 2016.

Mia Genovese, Source Water Specialist from NJ Water Associates presented her plan for a Source Water Protection Plan for the Borough, which is a water contamination risk assessment. She suggested a steering committee which is made up of volunteers from the Board of Health, Land Use Board, Historical Society and Municipal Alliance to help identify details on past contaminated sites, town history and water contamination prevention. A copy of the Source Water Protection Plan for Stanhope and Netcong was given to the board as an example of what the plan is.
