

WORK SESSION

June 28, 2010

A work session of the Mayor and Common Council of the Borough of Ogdensburg, Sussex County, New Jersey, was held in the Council Chambers, in the Borough Hall on June 28, 2010.

In the absence of the Mayor, Council President Steve Ciasullo called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Upon roll call the following Council Members appeared and answered the call: Blahut, Ciasullo, Hann, Ingerto, Wolstenholme, Wood.

Notice requirements of the Open Public Meeting Act, NJSA 10:4-6 have been satisfied with a schedule of all meetings, together with the time, location and agenda of same being sent to the New Jersey Herald and the New Jersey Sunday Herald, and posted on the bulletin board in the Borough Hall on January 4, 2010.

Councilman Hann moved, Councilman Wood seconded motion to adopt the following resolution.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Ogdensburg to transfer all the accounts from Lakeland Bank to Sussex Bank, which is part of the Borough's cash management plan. Yeas: Blahut, Ciasullo, Hann, Ingerto, Wolstenholme, Wood. Copy attached as Schedule 1.

Councilman Ingerto moved, Councilman Wood seconded motion to introduce an ordinance entitled **AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II ADMINISTRATION FEE SCHEDULE FOR VARIOUS BOROUGH DOCUMENTS, LICENSES, PERMITS AND BADGES OF THE GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF OGDENSBURG** on first reading. Public hearing is scheduled for July 12, 2010.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Borough of Ogdensburg that subsection 2-11 of Chapter II Administration Fee Schedule for Various Borough Documents, Licenses, Permits and Badges be amended to read as follows:

Certified copy of certificate of birth, death, marriage, civil union and domestic partnership \$10.00

Councilman Ciasullo moved, Councilman Hann seconded motion to open the public hearing on an ordinance entitled **AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER III, SECTION 12 OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF OGDENSBURG ENTITLED LICENSING AND REGULATING JUNKYARD KEEPERS AND DEALERS.**

Yeas: Blahut, Ciasullo, Hann, Ingerto, Wolstenholme, Wood.

There being no comment from the public, Councilman Ciasullo moved, Councilman Hann seconded motion to close the public hearing. Yeas: Blahut, Ciasullo, Hann, Ingerto, Wolstenholme, Wood.

Councilman Ciasullo moved, Councilman Hann seconded motion to adopt said ordinance. Yeas: Blahut, Ciasullo, Hann, Ingerto, Wolstenholme, Wood. Copy attached as Schedule 3.

DISCUSSION

Councilman Blahut discussed opening the recycling center with the donation given by Extreme Energy Solutions. Councilman Hann questioned as to whether Extreme Energy was in compliance. Councilman Ciasullo answered not yet but according to our Attorney, it is acceptable to accept the donation for the recycling center to open in July for the rest of the year. It was suggested to place small dumpsters instead of using the cans and to have it open for four hours on Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

Councilman Blahut moved, Councilman Wood seconded motion to reopen the Recycling Center on Saturdays from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. using the donation from Extreme Energy Solutions to pay for an attendant for the remainder of the year. Yeas: Blahut, Ciasullo, Hann, Ingerto, Wolstenholme, Wood. Councilman Blahut discussed school crossing guard and not having a crossing guard in September would be a safety concern and that the Borough may have to put this item back in the budget. Further discussion will be forthcoming. Councilman Blahut discussed the sign for the Senior Citizen of the year Ann Sekelsky. The same sign post will be used and the sign was donated by Councilman Blahut.

Councilman Hann briefly mentioned the 125 Insurance regarding any employees who would want to contribute. Councilman Hann asked to table this item until he has more information on it.

Councilman Ciasullo asked about the new sign at Heaters Pond. Councilman Ciasullo was informed the funds came out of the 5K run and cost about \$435.00. Councilman Ciasullo stated that any issue should come before Council for approval before moving forward. Councilman Ciasullo provided an update on Edison Road for Jeff Nafis, Emergency Management Coordinator from Sparta. He is waiting for specs from the Engineer for finishing the road. Councilman Ciasullo was asked how much will it cost and where is the funding coming from.

Councilman Wolstenholme stated that because of personal obligations he will have to step down as the liaison for the Land Use Board. After a brief discussion Councilman Ciasullo offered to fill in for Councilman Wolstenholme on the Land Use Board.

Councilman Wood moved, Councilman Ingerto seconded motion to appoint Councilman Ciasullo as the liaison for the Land Use Board. Yeas: Blahut, Ciasullo, Hann, Ingerto, Wolstenholme, Wood.

Councilman Ingerto discussed Department of Transportation funding for streets that need to be repaved and mentioned that he would like to start looking at roads. Councilman Ciasullo informed Mayor and Council that he received the specs on the Saw Mill Brook and will be looking for three estimates on the Saw Mill Brook for next meeting.

Councilman Wood moved, Councilman Ingerto seconded motion to open the public portion of the meeting. Yeas: Blahut, Ciasullo, Hann, Ingerto, Wolstenholme, Wood

There being no comment from the public Councilman Wood moved, Councilman Ciasullo seconded motion to close the public session. Yeas: Blahut, Ciasullo, Hann, Ingerto, Wolstenholme, Wood

There being no further business, Councilman Hann moved, Councilman Ciasullo seconded motion to adjourn the meeting. Yeas: Blahut, Ciasullo, Hann, Ingerto, Wolstenholme, Wood.
