

WORK SESSION
AUGUST 22, 2016

A work session of the Mayor and Common Council of the Borough of Ogdensburg, Sussex County, New Jersey, was held in the Council Chambers in the Borough Hall on August 22, 2016. In the absence of the Mayor, Council President George Hutnick called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Upon Roll Call the following Council Members appeared and answered the call: McGuire, Hutnick, Opilla. Absent: Astor, Rizzo, Slater.
