

	Minimum	Maximum
Mayor	\$2,500.00	\$4,500.00
Council Member	\$2,000.00	\$4,000.00


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all other provisions of Ordinance No. 11-2019 shall remain in full force and effect.


