**AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF THE OFFICES AND  
EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH OF OGDENSBURG AND REPEALING  
PRIOR ORDINANCES THEREFORE**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Common Council of the Borough of Ogdensburg that:


1. The following salaries for the offices hereinafter set forth for the year 2019 beginning January 1<sup>st</sup>, and each year thereafter until amended or repealed, are hereby established and fixed as the salary to be paid for the offices wherein the salaries are set at fixed figures, and for the offices wherein a minimum and maximum range is set for the salaries, the salaries shall be paid to the holder of said offices within the minimum and maximum range set by resolution of the Mayor and Common Council:

3. Overtime pay for Borough employees shall be determined by Article XIV, Section D of the Borough Employee's manual.
4. Bonuses, if any, shall be paid at the discretion of the Mayor and Council
5. All prior salary ordinances adopted by the Borough of Ogdensburg and any other ordinance or ordinances or portions thereof that may be inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby rescinded.
6. This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption and publication according to law.
