# BOROUGH OF OGDENSBURG COUNTY OF SUSSEX ORDINANCE 03-2023

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF OGDENSBURG, COUNTY OF SUSSEX, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY ADDING CHAPTER 18 TO THE BOROUGH CODE ENTITLED "MUNICIPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEM (MS4), TIER A COMMUNITY-WIDE ORDINANCES" INCLUDING NEW SECTION 18-1 ENTITLED "PET WASTE"

WHEREAS, in July 2022, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection ("NJDEP") reassigned all New Jersey municipalities designated as "Tier B" under the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System Permit Program (MS4 Permit Program) to "Tier A" effectively invalidating the "Tier B" permit program; and

WHEREAS, as a result of Tier A reassignment, the Borough of Ogdensburg ("Borough") is required to satisfy additional permit conditions set forth in the Tier A MS4 New Jersey Pollutant Discharge Elimination System ("NJPDES") Master General Permit renewed January 1, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Tier A NJPDES permit conditions require, among other things, that the Borough adopt and enforce community-wide ordinances regarding (1) Pet Waste, (2) Wildlife Feeding, (3) Litter Control, (4) Improper Disposal of Waste, (5) Containerized Yard Waste/Yard Waste, (6) Private Storm Drain Inlet Retrofitting, (7) Privately-Owned Salt Storage, (8) Tree Removal/Replacement, (9) Illicit Connection, and (10) Privately-Owned Refuse Container/Dumpster (optional); and

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to adopt the aforesaid ordinances throughout the course of this calendar year for better legislative management and increased public participation, which ordinances shall appear in a new chapter of the Borough Code entitled "Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4), Tier A Community-Wide Ordinances."

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Ogdensburg, County of Sussex, and State of New Jersey, that Chapter 18 entitled "Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4), Tier A Community-Wide Ordinances" be added to the Code of the Borough, together with Section 18-1 entitled "Pet Waste" as follows:

**SECTION 1**. There is hereby created in the Borough Code a new chapter entitled "Chapter 18 Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4), Tier A Community-Wide Ordinances."

**SECTION 2.** Section 18-1 entitled "Pet Waste" is hereby added to Chapter 18 of the Borough Code as Follows:

Chapter 18 Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4), Tier A Community-Wide Ordinances

§ 18-1 PET WASTE

#### § 18-1.1 Purpose.

The purpose of this Section is to establish requirements for the proper disposal of pet solid waste in the Borough of Ogdensburg to protect public health, safety, and welfare, and to prescribe penalties for failure to comply.

#### § 18-1.2 Definitions.

For the purpose of this Section, the following terms, phrases, words and their derivations shall have the meanings stated herein unless their use in the text of this article clearly demonstrates a different meaning. When not inconsistent with the context, words used in the present tense include the future, words used in the plural number include the singular number, and words used in the singular number include the plural number. The word "shall" is always mandatory and not merely directory.

### **IMMEDIATE**

The pet solid waste is removed at once, without delay.

#### OWNER/KEEPER

Any person who shall possess, maintain, house, or harbor any pet or otherwise have custody of any pet, whether or not the owner of such pet.

### **PERSON**

Any individual, corporation, company, partnership, firm, association, or political subdivision of this state subject to municipal jurisdiction.

#### PET

A domesticated animal (other than a disability assistance animal) kept for amusement or companionship.

#### PET SOLID WASTE

Waste matter expelled from the bowels of the pet; excrement.

#### PROPER DISPOSAL

Placement in a designated waste receptacle, or other suitable container, and discarded in a refuse container which is regularly emptied by the municipality or some other refuse collector; or disposal into a system designed to convey domestic sewage for proper treatment and disposal.

### § 18-1.3 Requirements for Disposal.

All pet owners and keepers are required to immediately and properly dispose of their pet's solid waste deposited on any property, public or private, not owned or possessed by that person.

## § 18-1.4 Exemptions.

Any owner or keeper who requires the use of a disability assistance animal shall be exempt from the provisions of this section while such animal is being used for that purpose.

# § 18-1.5 Enforcement.

The provisions of this Section shall be enforced by the Police Department and the Local Board of Health of the Borough of Ogdensburg.

# § 18-1.6 Violations and Penalties.

Any person(s) who is found to be in violation of this Section shall be subject to a minimum fine of not less than \$50 nor maximum fine more than \$250 for each and every violation.

**SECTION 3.** All other provisions unaffected by this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 4.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed.

SECTION 5. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or a portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

**SECTION 6.** This ordinance shall become effective after second reading and publication as required by law.
